Terms and Conditions



1. There are two ways to enter:
 - Collect form from St Peter and St Paul Church Olney and return to the church office (or the pigeon hole) by Midday on Friday 14th June
 - Download a form from www.olneycherryfair.org.uk or <https://www.facebook.com/OlneyCherryFair/> and return by email to office@olney.church by Midday Friday 14th June
2. Entry fee = donations to the church fund. This is to be brought when you deliver your model and put into the collection buckets.
3. Models to be delivered between 10am and midday on 15th June 2019 to the St Peter and St Paul Church – you will be issued with a number to place with your model.
4. Models to be no larger than a base of 25cm x 25cm
5. Judging will take place between midday and 1pm on 15th June 2019
6. Prizes are given for the first three places in each category
 - 1st = £3, 2nd = £2 and 3rd = £1
 - Certificates awarded for first three places in each category
7. Categories are as follows:
 - A) Models from any materials i) Under 5yrs ii) 5 – 11 yrs iii) 12 - 15yrs
 - B) Lego Model (not kit form) i) Under 5yrs ii) 5 – 11 yrs iii) 12 - 15yrs
 - C) Adult Lego Model (not kit form) – 16yrs and over
8. Only one entry per person per category (Categories are A, B, C)
9. All exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor
10. The judges decision is final
11. Prize money can be collected after judging from the entrance gate of the Glebe Field.
12. St Peter and St Paul Church cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage to exhibits
13. Exhibits must be collected between 3.30pm and 4pm on the 15th June 2019 – The church cannot be held responsible for the safety or loss of the models after this time.
